State boards are required to comply with the 2009 Code of Practice for the Governance of state bodies and to formally confirm compliance with the provisions of the code. In addition the code states that the board should satisfy itself that all statutory obligations are identified and made known to it as part of the compliance obligation. This provision alone has profound implications for both the board and the executive.

This special event will review and explain the main statutory and regulatory obligations on state boards and public service organisations, as many are completing the compliance statement to supplement the annual report.

The session will also include specialist contributions on the broad area of employment law and recent developments in this area, data protection and also the specific obligations of the new code.

LEAD PRESENTERS

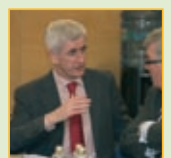
